Class 7: 100cm Eventer's Challenge

Class 8: 90cm Eventer's Challenge

Important information:

A4 paper numbers will be supplied so please bring your own number bib. A small number of bibs will be available to buy on the day.

Medical armbands are compulsory for all competitors. They are available from the BHS, BRC and Pony Club.

Please remember to carefully check the new hat and body protector standards for BRC. Only current standards will be allowed AND WILL BE CHECKED.

Summary of the rules and scoring:

- Riders to wear x/c clothing for both phases as competition is run directly from sj phase to the x/c
 - All classes will be judged against an optimum time.
 - 80cm class x/c phase to be ridden at 435m/min
 - 90cm classes x/c phase to be ridden at 450m/min
 - 100cm classes x/c phase to be ridden at 475m/min
 - Show jumping phases to be ridden at 325m/min for all classes
 - 0.4 time penalties for each second over or under the optimum time on x/c
 - Show Jumping Phase: 1 penalty will be given for every 1 second in excess of the time allowed
 - FULL RULES AND DETAILS OF SCORING WILL BE FOUND IN THE BRC RULEBOOK AVAILABLE ON THE BRC WEBSITE

General Conditions and Rules of Entry:

1. This event will run under Riding Club rules and the Chief Steward's decision is final. All complaints must be put in writing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £20 within 15 minutes of the incident, returnable if the objection is upheld.
 2. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges or Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
 3. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. ALL RIDERS, whether competing or not, must wear the correct headgear with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. The following hats are acceptable PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) and must have BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC mark, VG1 01.040 (2014-12) and must have BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC mark, ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) and must have SEI mark, SNELL E2001 or E2016, AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) and must have SAI Global mark
 4. Only a 'Jockey Skull' complying with to the above standards may be worn for any XC phase. This must not have a peak, any peak type extensions or noticeable protuberances above the eyes or in front and should have an even round or elliptical shape with smooth or slightly abrasive surface. A removable hat cover with a light flexible peak may be used if required.
 5. Failure to wear the correct headgear will result in elimination. BRC members in qualifying classes must present untagged hats for checking and tagging when collecting numbers.
 6. Competitors must wear BETA Class 3 (purple label) 2009 body protectors and medical armbands worn on the arm (obtainable from, BHS, BRC and Pony Club).
 7. No stop watches may be worn by competitors
 8. All horses competing must be at least 5 years old
 9. A refund (less admin fee) will be issued for withdrawn entries on production of a medical/veterinary Certificate or at the Secretary's discretion. Should the event be cancelled a 50% admin fee will be retained.
 10. **DOGS are ONLY allowed in the lorry park and must be kept on leads (non-extending) at all times**
 11. **The car/lorry park must be left tidy. Please do not tie hay nets outside lorries/trailers and all rubbish/droppings must be taken home**
